Two Persons In Custody After Meth Lab Found

Two persons are in custody after deputies located meth lab components on Fleetwood Lane near Clinton. Investigators with the Sheriff's Special Operations Unit went to the home on Monday, September 27, after receiving an anonymous tip that meth was being made and a wanted person was living there. Investigators saw meth making items under the front porch and spoke with **Amy Kay Wilson** who allowed them to search the mobile home. At first deputies could not locate the wanted person, **Wesley Brian Rains**, but were later told he had went to a trap door in the bedroom and was hiding under the trailer. A trap door was indeed found in the floor. **Rains** refused to come out and deputies had to go underneath the mobile home to take him into custody. Additional meth related items were found inside the home and discarded remains of a meth lab were found in the woods near the mobile home park.

Both **Wesley Brian Rains** and **Amy Kay Wilson** were arrested on methamphetamine charges and **Rains** was served with several outstanding warrants.
