Three Arrests In Claxton Pharmacy Robbery

Three persons are in custody charged with the December 27 robbery of Mac's Pharmacy on Edgemoor Road in Claxton. **Zachary Beau Haynes**, 24, was arrested last Thursday, December 30, on McSpadden Street in Knoxville, by investigators with both the Knox and Anderson County Sheriff's Departments. **Haynes** was charged by Anderson County Sheriff's investigators in the Claxton robbery and also by Knox County Sheriff's detectives for the December 28 robbery of the CVS Pharmacy on Emory Road. He had several unrelated outstanding warrants as well. **Haynes** is being held in the Knox County Detention Facility.

Additional drug charges were placed on **Armas** upon her arrest. **Montgomery** and **Armas** are being held in the Anderson County Detention Facility.
