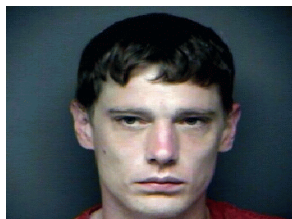

Five Arrests After Deputies Nab Burglary Suspects

Five persons are in custody after alert sheriff's deputies spot suspects in two separate burglaries. The first two were arrested Friday, April 20, after Corporal Wally Braden stopped a car for speeding on Mountain Road in Andersonville. Corporal Braden noticed a flat screen television in the back seat. When questioned, the occupants of the car became nervous and evasive. While Corporal Braden and other deputies were investigating, a residential burglary was reported on Hinds Creek Road. Upon speaking with the homeowner, it was discovered a flat screen television and other items were stolen. The serial number of the television found in the back seat matched that of the one taken. Upon further investigation, other items taken in the burglary were recovered. **James Kevin Robinson**, 26, of Wallace Lane in Andersonville and **James Dustin Coker**, 21, of Teller Village in Oak Ridge were arrested and charged with burglary and theft. The female driver of the car was questioned but no charges were filed pending further investigation.

Robinson and **Coker** have prior arrests in Anderson and Knox Counties. Both are being held in the Anderson County Detention Facility. Bonds are pending arraignment.

The second incident occurred on Saturday, April 21, after a residential burglary was reported on Ross Cemetery Road near Lake City. Neighbors of the homeowner saw a suspicious vehicle and two men carrying items from the home. Sheriff's dispatchers broadcast the suspect's descriptions and the vehicle. Several deputies responded and the suspects were spotted by Deputy Jeremy Baker on Lovely Bluff Road. Upon stopping the vehicle, four persons were detained.

After investigation, two of the four persons were charged with the burglary. **Curtis Lynn Lowe**, 34, of McAdoo Street in Clinton and **Dillard Alan Welch**, 44, of Longmire Road, Clinton, were arrested for burglary and theft. A third, **Teddy Mack Huckaby**, 28, of Coral Circle in Powell, was arrested on an outstanding capias for a drug offense. The fourth person initially gave deputies a false name and will be charged at a later date. Additional charges may be filed pending further investigation.
