Four Arrests After Robbery, Home Invasion

Four persons are in custody after two separate robberies that occurred on Saturday, December 15. Just before 6:30pm, a man robbed the clerk at knife point at the Town Talk Market on Lake City Highway. The suspect threatened to cut the clerk's throat. He was accompanied by another man and a woman. Witnesses gave deputies the description of the vehicle they were in which was broadcast to all area law enforcement agencies. Through investigation, sheriff's investigators learned the identity of the robbery suspect and this information was also sent out.

Shortly after 8:00pm, deputies were called to a home on Sulphur Springs Road where a man and woman had come to the residence and asked to use the telephone. Once inside the man threatened to kill the victim and demanded his wallet. Deputies linked this robbery to the same suspect as the Town Talk robbery.

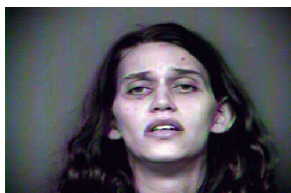
The suspect vehicle was spotted by deputies at a convenience store in Clinton and, assisted by the Clinton Police Department, three persons were taken into custody. **Gary Wayne Lowe**, 52, of Nashville (formerly of Clinton), **Misty Dawn Gurley**, 28, of Clinton, and **Brandi Marie (Berry) Bugg**, 25, also of Clinton, were each charged with offenses relating to the robberies. **Gary Wayne Lowe** is currently on parole after serving time in prison.

He will be held in the Knox County Detention Facility with a hold for Anderson County on the robbery charges as well as other outstanding warrants.
