#### Two Arrests After Heroin Sales

Two persons are in custody after an investigation into sales of heroin. **Charles Randolph Johnson**, 38, and **Joe Fentress Butler**, 27, were arrested on Thursday, January 31, after a search warrant was served at their Oak Ridge Mobile Home Park residence. Investigators with the Sheriff's Special Operations Unit had purchased heroin at the residence as part of a drug investigation and a search warrant was obtained. Heroin and drug paraphernalia were found during the search. Both **Johnson** and **Butler** were charged with numerous drug offenses including Violation of the Drug Free School Zone as the mobile home is within 1,000 feet of Claxton Elementary School.

**Bond Pending Arraignment**

While **Johnson** and **Butler** were living in the mobile home park, neither is from this area with both being from out-of-state. **Johnson** is also wanted in Michigan for a parole violation but they will not extradite him from Tennessee. Both have extensive criminal records.

This investigation is continuing and both **Johnson** and **Butler** are being held in the Anderson County Detention Facility without bond pending their arraignment.
