Memorial Day Traffic Safety



The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will take part in the *Click It or Ticket - National Seat Belt Enforcement Mobilization* by conducting saturation patrols during this Memorial Day holiday period. A sobriety checkpoint will also be held the evening of Friday, May 24, on Tri-County Boulevard in Oliver Springs. This will be a multi-agency effort sponsored by the Oliver Springs Police Department and the Governor's Highway Safety Office.

The *Click It or Ticket - National Seat Belt Enforcement Mobilization* runs from May 20th through June 2nd, 2013.

Seat belts are the most effective safety feature ever invented and have helped save thousands of lives. Sadly, one in five Americans fail to regularly wear a seat belt when driving or riding in a motor vehicle. Remember, buckle up – each time... every time.
