Labor Day Traffic Safety

The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will be out in force this Labor Day holiday as part of the "Drive Sober Or Get Pulled Over" crackdown on drunk driving. This effective nationwide campaign will include high-visibility enforcement throughout Anderson County.



The "Drive Sober Or Get Pulled Over" campaign will take aim at drunk and impaired drivers with increased enforcement. The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will take part in this campaign by conducting saturation patrols during the Labor Day holiday period which runs through September 2nd.

The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will also be conducting saturation enforcement on September 6th and 7th as well as September 13th and 14th. These saturations will take aim at impaired or drunk drivers, aggressive drivers, reckless drivers, and those not wearing their seat belts.

Driving drunk is simply not worth the risk. So don't take the chance. Remember, we will be out in force and we will be watching, so "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over".
