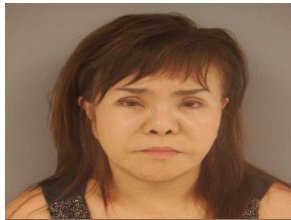

Two Arrests After Prostitution Investigation

Two persons were arrested yesterday afternoon, Tuesday, April 29, after an investigation into prostitution activity at a "spa" that had just opened in Anderson County. Sheriff's officials learned of a business, "King Accupressure", that opened on Andersonville Highway. After being notified by the Law Director's Office, an investigation began that ultimately led Sheriff's officials to believe prostitution activity was occurring.

Yesterday, an undercover operation was conducted and an employee of the business offered a sexual act to a Sheriff's investigator in exchange for money. **Young Hwa Park**, 56, and **Chong Kim**, 68, both of Duluth, Georgia, were charged with prostitution offenses.

Both **Park** and **Kim** were booked into the Anderson County Detention Facility. **Park** was later released on bond.

The business license for "King Accupressure" was seized as it was fraudulently obtained. In addition, it was learned the landlords of the property were unaware of the true nature of the business as it had been misrepresented to them as well.

Quick work by investigators from the Sheriff's Special Operations Unit resulted in two arrests and an unlawful business closed shortly after opening.
