#### **Memorial Day Traffic Safety**



The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will take part in the *Click It or Ticket - National Seat Belt Enforcement Mobilization* by conducting saturation patrols during this Memorial Day holiday period. A sobriety checkpoint will also be held the evening of Friday, May 23, on Tri-County Boulevard in Oliver Springs. This will be a multi-agency effort sponsored by the Oliver Springs Police Department and the Governor's Highway Safety Office.

The *Click It or Ticket - National Seat Belt Enforcement Mobilization* runs from May 19<sup>th</sup> through June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

Seat belts are the most effective safety feature ever invented and have helped save thousands of lives. Sadly, one in five Americans fail to regularly wear a seat belt when driving or riding in a motor vehicle.
