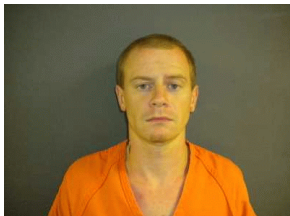

#### Two Arrests In Home Burglary

Two persons were arrested yesterday evening, Tuesday, June 10, after burglarizing a home in the Marlow Community. Sheriff's deputies responded to a report of a burglary-in-progress about 8:42pm on Binkley Acres Lane near Oliver Springs. The homeowner was contacted by a neighbor who saw a strange car in the driveway. The owner went to the home and saw the vehicle parked at the gate near the entrance to his driveway. Upon checking his property, he observed two persons inside the home. The homeowner called 911 and deputies responded.

The first deputy arrived in less than a minute of being dispatched, spoke with the owner, and waited until the two men exited the residence carrying items they had just stolen. At that point the deputy's backup had not yet arrived but the suspects were apprehended without incident. **Marcus Dewayne Bowling**, 29, of Heiskell, and **Cody Aaron Sexton**, 23, of Oak Ridge, were arrested and charged with several offenses related to the burglary. Both remain in the Anderson County Detention Facility.
