Arrest In Second Gang-Related Attempted Murder

One person was arrested Saturday, August 9, after an indictment was returned in a gang-related attempted murder and assault case. Investigators obtained the indictment on **Cameron Reid Lowry**, 35, from the Anderson County Grand Jury after an investigation into the assault and attempted murder of a 31 year old Oak Ridge man. The incident occurred in Oak Ridge in November of 2013. The person charged in this case is a member of the Aryan Nations gang.

This arrest is the result of an investigation which has been ongoing for several months and is a cooperative effort between the Anderson County Sheriff's Department and the 7th Judicial District Crime Task Force which includes officers from the Sheriff's Department, and the Oak Ridge, Clinton, Lake City, and Oliver Springs Police Departments, as well as the District Attorney General's Office.

The District Attorney General's Office will be seeking enhanced penalties in this case as the offender is a member of a criminal gang.
