Labor Day Traffic Safety

The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will be out in force this Labor Day holiday as part of the "Drive Sober Or Get Pulled Over" crackdown on drunk driving. This effective nationwide campaign will include high-visibility enforcement throughout Anderson County.



The "Drive Sober Or Get Pulled Over" campaign will focus on drunk and impaired drivers with increased enforcement. The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will take part in this campaign by saturation patrols during the Labor Day holiday period which runs through September 1st.

The Anderson County Sheriff's Department will be conducting a Drunk Driving Prevention Campaign on Friday, August 29th, in cooperation with the Tennessee Highway Patrol. Sheriff's deputies and state troopers will take aim at impaired or drunk drivers throughout Anderson County in an effort to reduce traffic crashes and fatalities.

Driving drunk is not worth the risk. So don't take chances. Remember, law enforcement will be out in force and will be watching, so "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over".
