#### Three Arrests After Home Burglary

Sheriff's deputies arrested three persons after a burglary was reported just after 2:00pm, Tuesday January 26, on East Wolf Valley Road in Heiskell. The homeowner, along with her three young grandchildren, came home to find a car parked behind her residence. She called 911 and waited at the entrance to her driveway. The car and the three occupants fled from the home, striking the homeowner's truck as they did so. A witness driving by saw the incident, called 911, and followed a short distance as the car fled toward Norris Freeway. A description of the suspect's car was broadcast and several deputies responded to the area.

The car was spotted by Deputy Rick Coley as it turned onto Norris Freeway. The driver fled from Deputy Coley before finally stopping near the Knox County line. Assisted by Knox County deputies, the three occupants were taken into custody. Items were found in the car that came from the burglary and other stolen property was located after being tossed from the car during the pursuit.

Arrested were **Justen Wayne Hatmaker**, 19, of Cane Creek Road, Lake City; **Brittany Denise Crowe**, 20, of Tipton Lane, Knoxville; and **Trina Cristella Blalock**, 23, of Corbin Hill Road, Oliver Springs. Each was charged based upon the results of the investigation.
