Four Arrests After Home Burglary

Three adults and one juvenile were arrested yesterday, Wednesday, August 18, after a residential burglary on Laurel Road near Clinton. Friends of the homeowner contacted him after seeing some other acquaintances come to the residence. The friends returned and found a television missing. A description of the car was broadcast and deputies located it on Lonesome Dove Road in Claxton.

After determining the circumstances of the incident, four persons were arrested. Christopher Logan Jett, 20; his sister, Cody Leann Garner, 21; Samir Joseph Awais, 19; and a 16 year old female juvenile were each charged in this case. Jett also had outstanding warrants in Knox County.



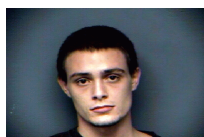
